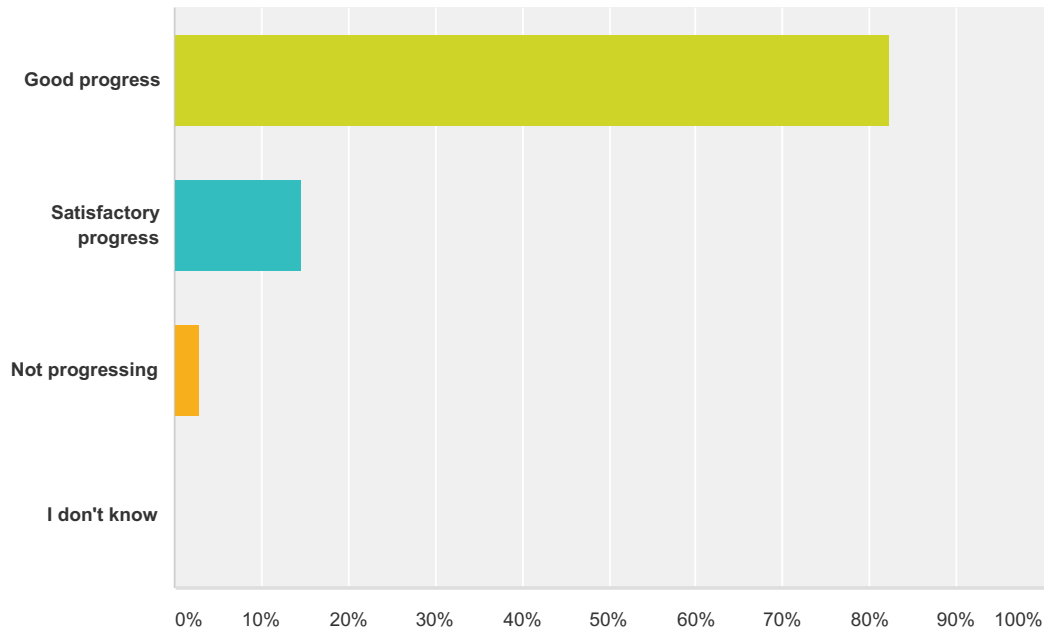

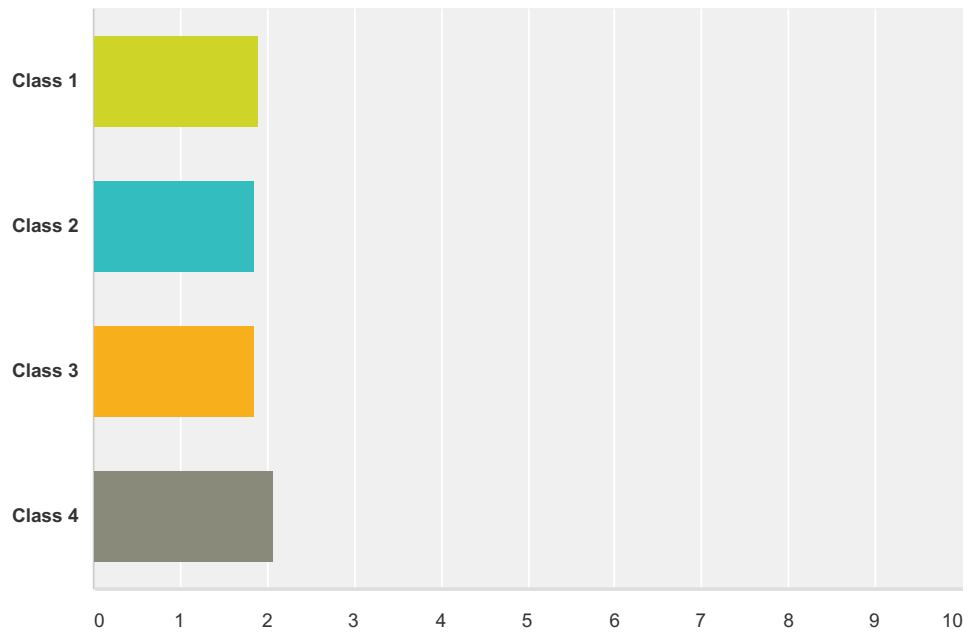

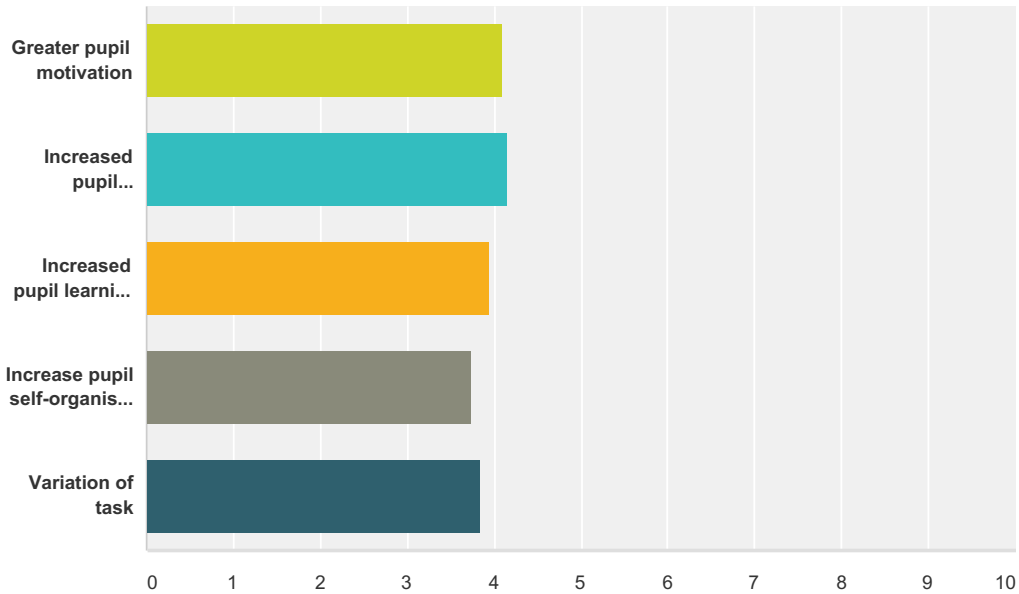

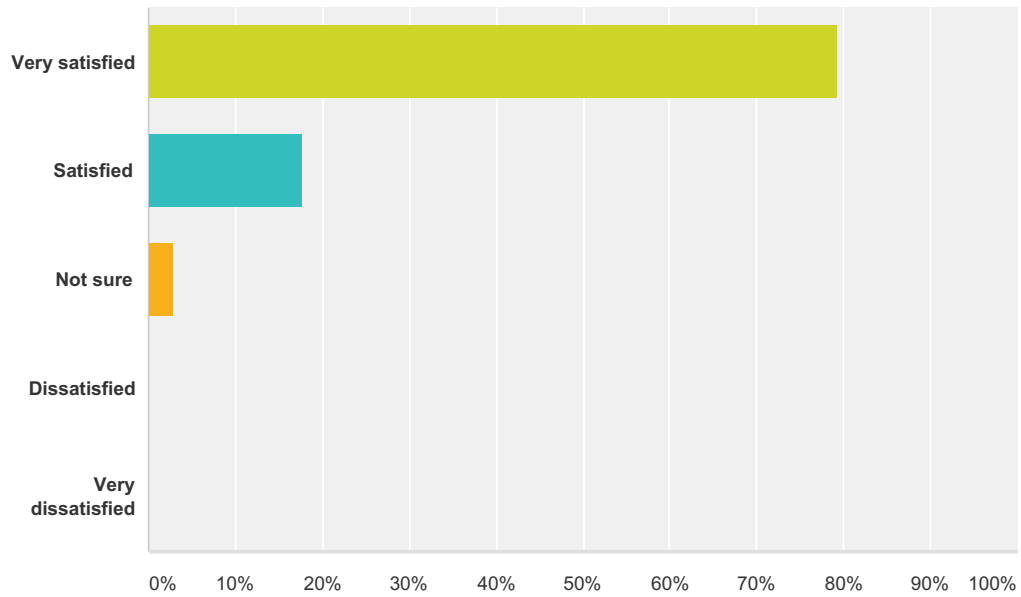

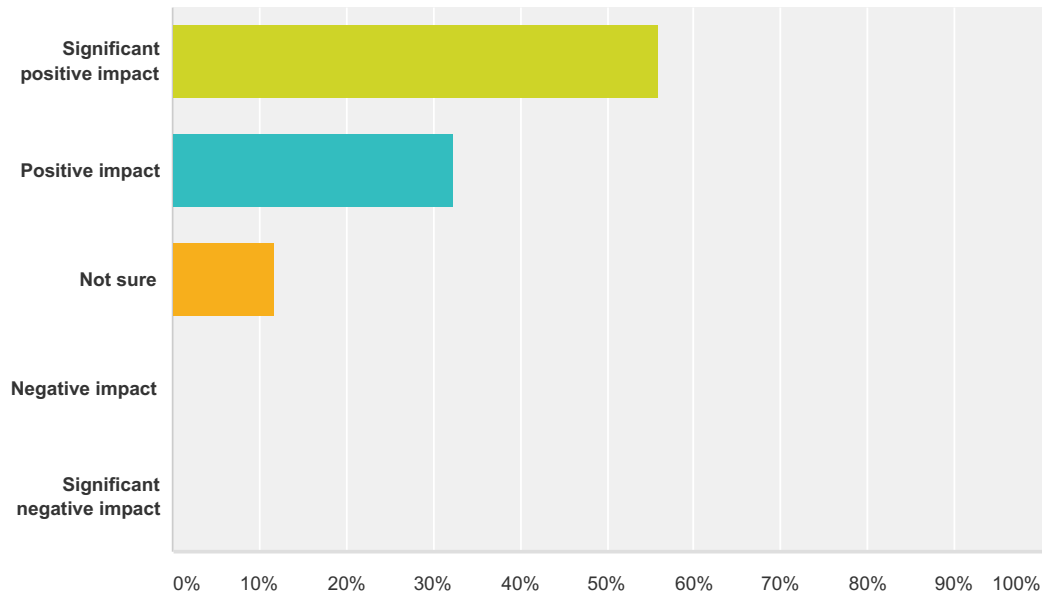

Q6 LEARNING: What impact do you consider ICT to have on your child's learning at Nether Alderley?

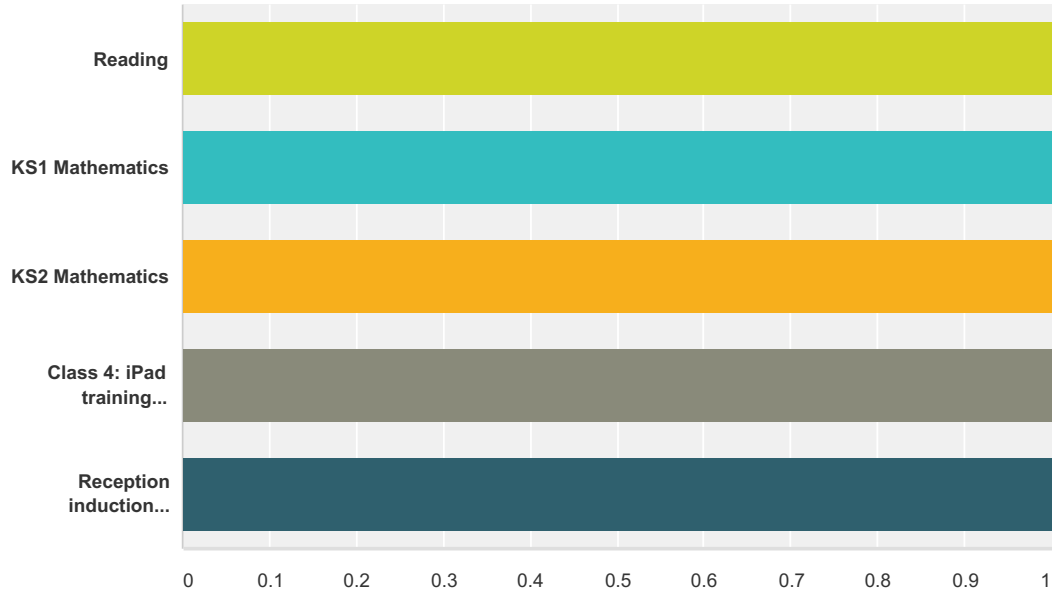

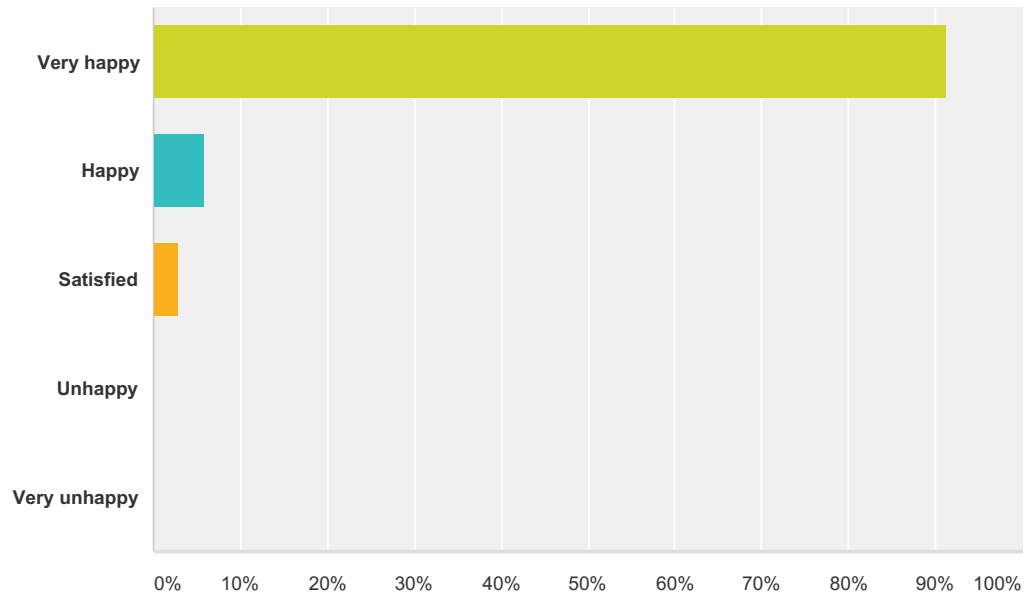

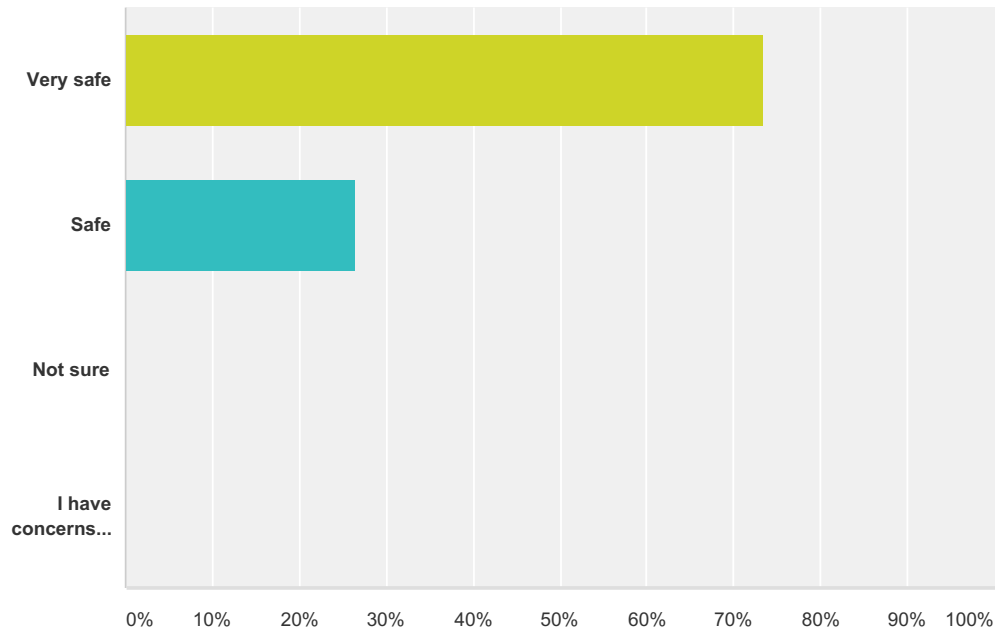

Q10 BEHAVIOUR & WELFARE: How safe do you feel your child is at Nether Alderley Primary School?

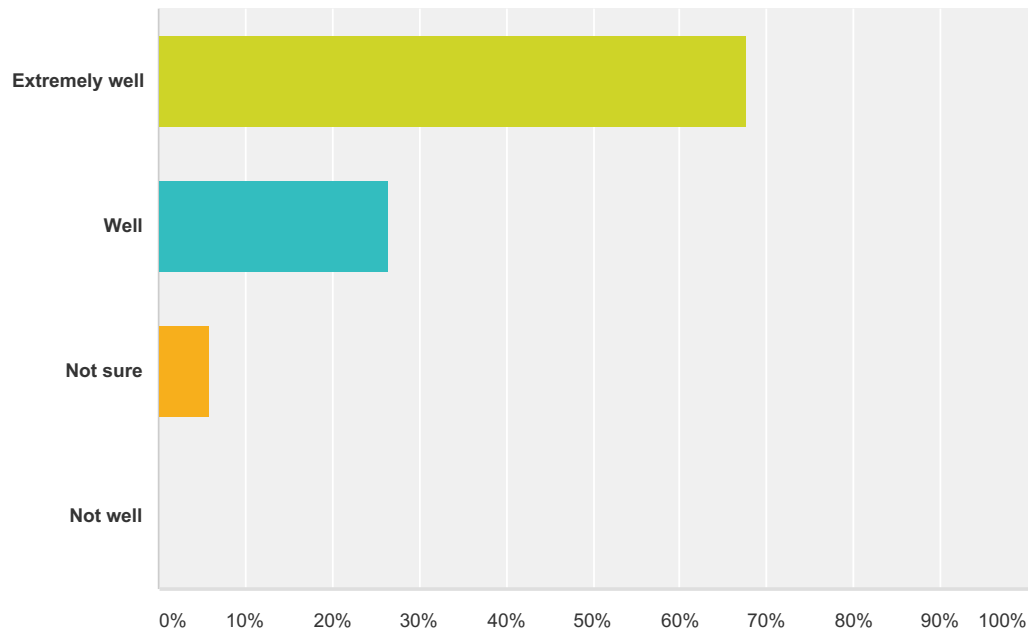

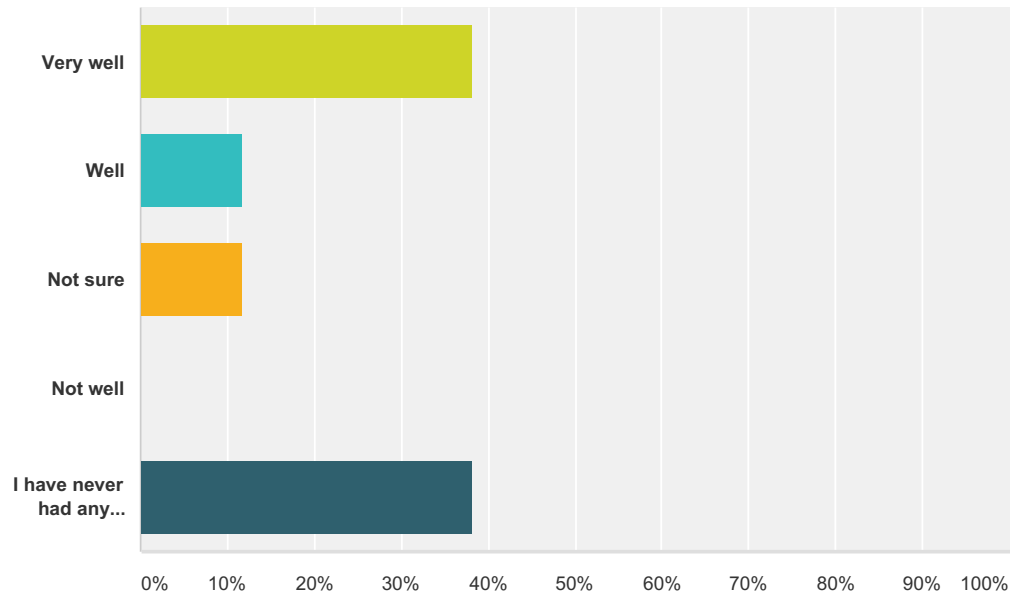

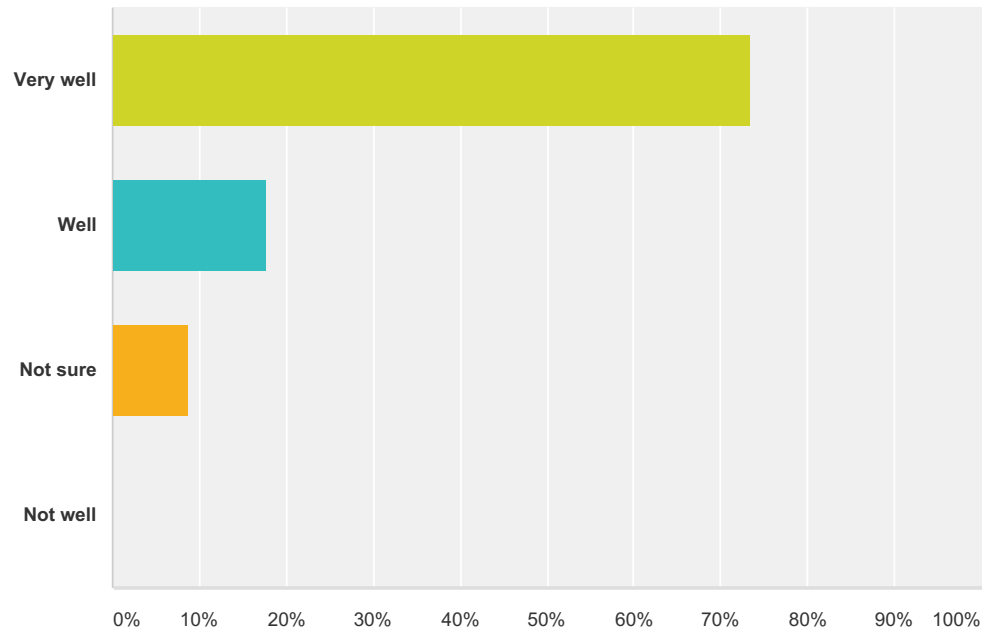

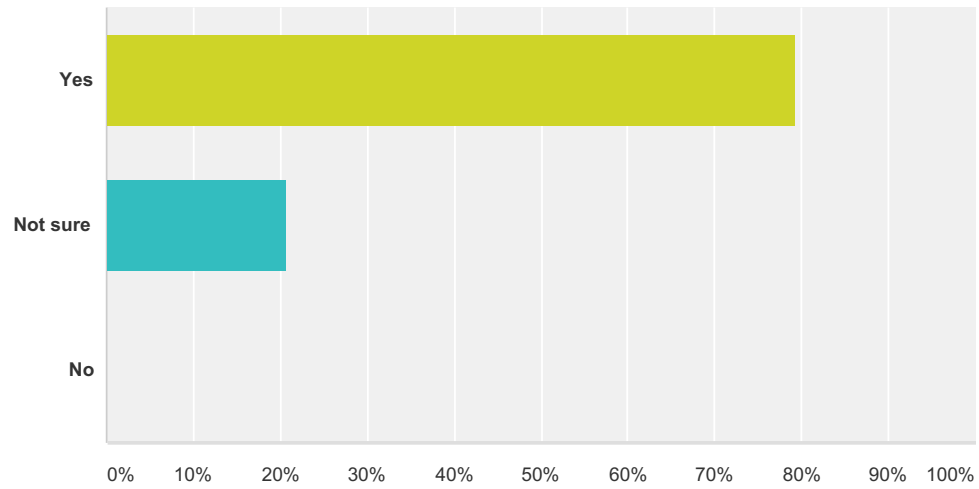

Q14 BEHAVIOUR & WELFARE: Does your child know who they can talk to at school if they have a problem?

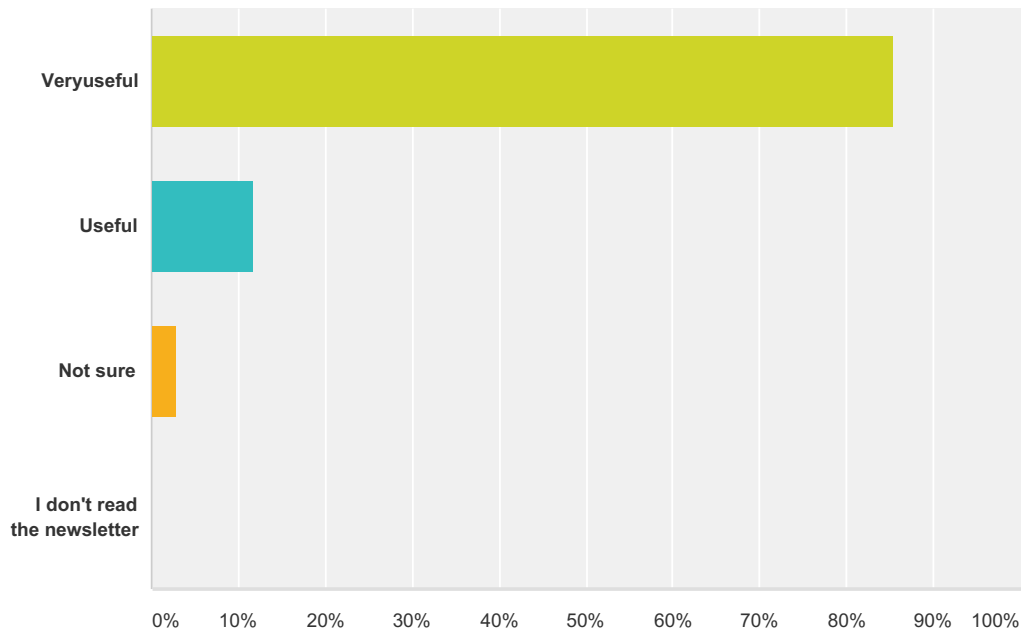

Q15 COMMUNICATION: Do you find the weekly newsletter useful?

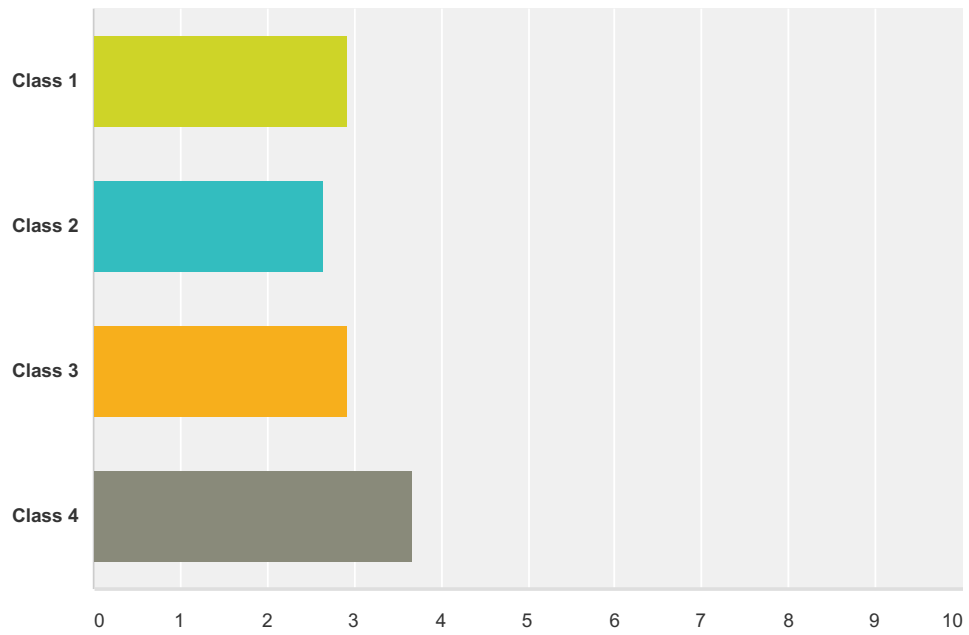

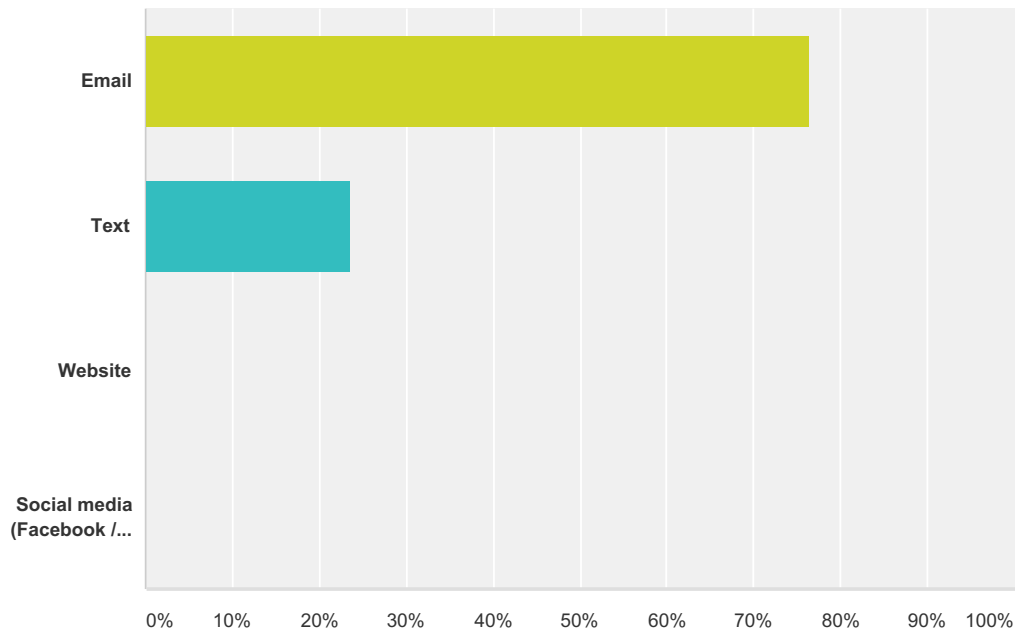

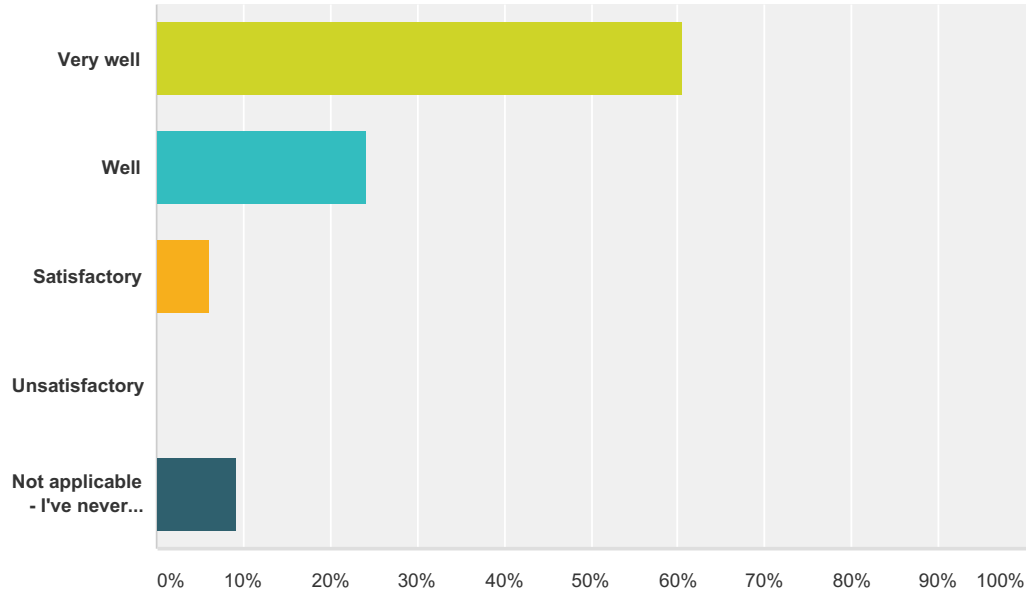

Q18 LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT: How well does the school respond when you raise concerns?

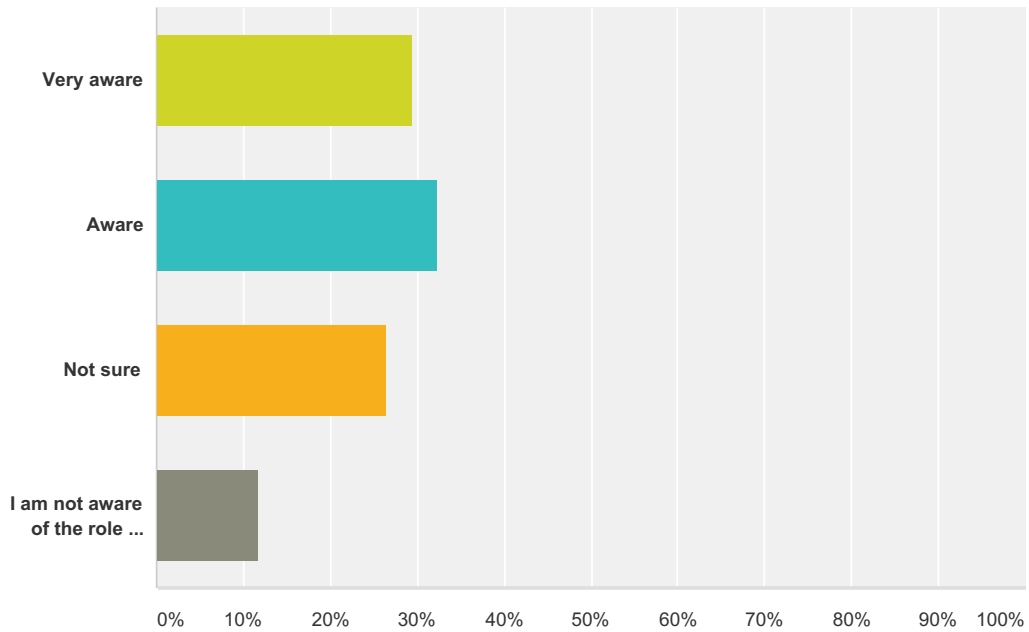

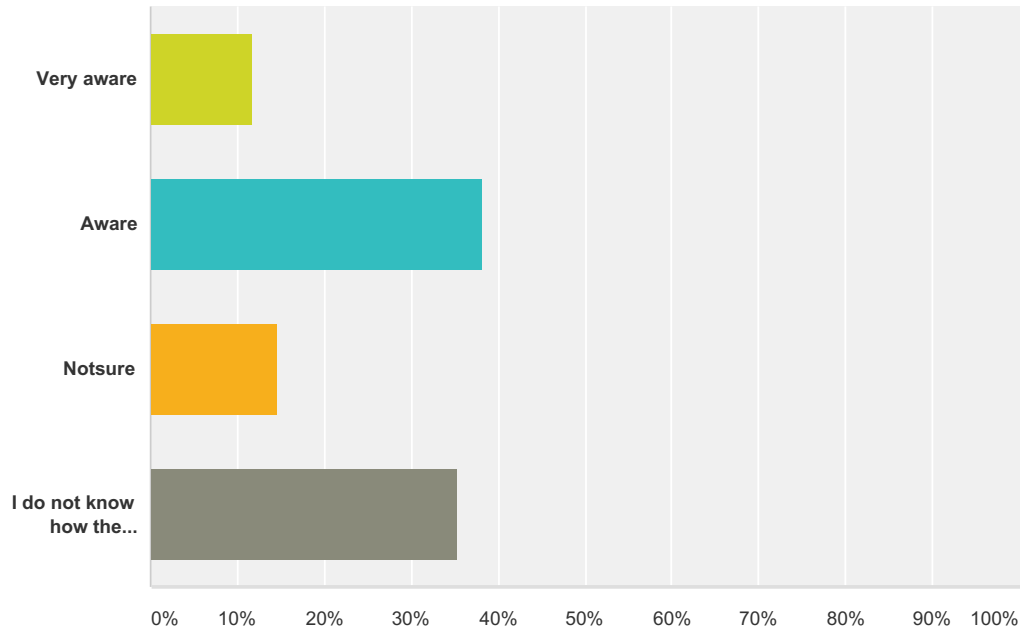

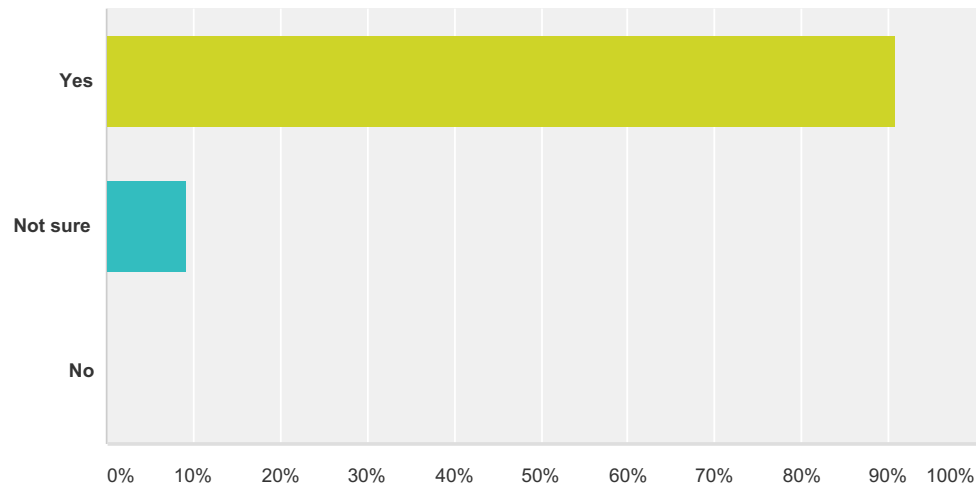

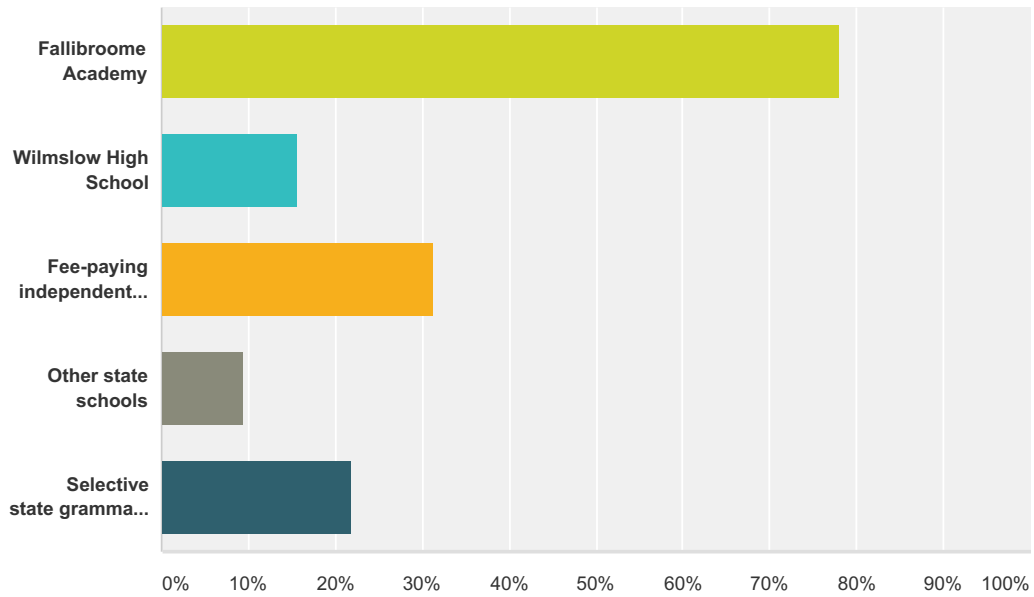
