

P.E. / Sports grant

In 2016-17 Nether Alderley will receive £8445 of funding from government.

What is it for?

This funding is to increase the participation of pupils in sports. It is to promote the importance of exercise in sustaining a healthy lifestyle.

How do we spend the funding ?

This funding has been used to ensure all pupils engage in high quality PE lessons and enjoy competitive events, both in and out of school.

- We employ a PE specialist teacher who:-
 - delivers high quality PE lesson to all classes each week
 - runs lunchtime and after school clubs such as Phys Kids (EYFS), gymnastics, basketball and hockey.
 - organises and runs, with the support of our sports captains, “intra” events (see Appendix A) in which children represent their houses and compete against each other to win the house cup
 - takes teams of pupils to participate in inter-school competitions in the Fallibroome cluster and Macclesfield School Sports Partnership events
- We buy into the Macclesfield Schools Sports Partnership (MSSP) which provides opportunities to take part in inter-school competitive events – see Appendix B list of MSSP events we will be taking part in. This also entitles us to a range of coaching in school. In 2016-17 we will pay for cricket and golf coaches to visit the school and coach the children, the provision of which will be further enhanced from our school budget. The MSSP also offers CPD opportunities for the staff in our school.
- We pay a subscription to the The Fallibroome Academy, towards a member of their staff who organises cluster events for the feeder schools – see appendix B for a list of the events we will be taking part in.

What impact does the funding have ?

The children at Nether Alderley are fit and healthy. They enjoy exercising in the spacious school grounds at playtimes. They benefit from having specialist coaches in gaining skills and knowledge about a wider range of sports and PE activities.

The impact of our actions is measured in many ways. We collect information on how much our children enjoy their PE lessons and competitions in pupil questionnaires and via our school council.

The uptake for our after-school sports activities is very good. There are many opportunities to take part in team events and despite being a very small school, there is competition for places.

In 2013-14 Nether Alderley achieved the Sainsburys Activemark Bronze award and in 2014-15 we achieved the silver award.
