

Information about becoming a parent governor

At Nether Alderley we have four parent governor roles on the governing body.

A full governing body meeting takes place every term (three per year), usually during the second half of each term.

Governors join a committee and in the first half term, each committee will meet and then report back at the full governors meeting.

The committees are as follows:

- Curriculum
- Staffing
- Premises and finance
- Special projects
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Additional meetings will take place as required e.g. the staffing committee will meet for staff recruitment.

Governors will take on roles of responsibility and will meet with staff at school to undertake a review of practice and latest developments and then report back at the full governing body meeting.

- Special educational needs
- Safeguarding
- Health and safety
- English
- Mathematics
- Science
- I.C.T.

From time to time governors will also undertake a more general visit to sample a typical school day.

Being a governor requires the school to undertake a Disclosure Barring Service (D.B.S.) background check to ensure suitability for working with children.
