

P.E. & Sports Premium funding 2018-19

Nether Alderley will receive £17,060 of funding from government.

What is it for?

This funding is to increase the participation of pupils in sports. It is to promote the importance of exercise in sustaining a healthy lifestyle.

How will we spend the funding ?

This funding will be used to ensure all pupils engage in high quality PE lessons and enjoy competitive events, both in and out of school.

1. We employ a PE specialist teacher who:-

- delivers high quality PE lesson to all classes each week
- runs lunchtime and after school clubs such as tag rugby, gymnastics, basketball and hockey.
- organises and runs, with the support of our sports captains, "intra" events (see Appendix A) in which children represent their houses and compete against each other to win the house cup
- takes teams of pupils to participate in inter-school competitions in the Fallibroome cluster and Macclesfield School Sports Partnership events

2. We will buy into the Macclesfield Schools Sports Partnership (MSSP) which provides opportunities for our pupils to take part in inter-school competitive events.

3. We pay a subscription to the The Fallibroome Academy, towards a member of their staff who organises cluster events for the feeder schools.

4. We will pay for sports coaches to come to the school and coach the children. In 2017 -18 we paid for dance, hockey, cricket and golf coaches.

5. We will pay fees to organisations where we take the children off-site to use their facilities. In 2017-18 we paid for the pupils to do badminton, hockey and archery off-site.

What impact does the funding have ?

The children at Nether Alderley are fit and healthy. They enjoy exercising in the spacious school grounds at playtimes. They benefit from having specialist coaches in gaining skills and knowledge about a wider range of sports and PE activities.

The impact of our actions is measured in many ways. We collect information on how much our children enjoy their PE lessons and competitions in pupil questionnaires and via our school council.

The uptake for our after-school sports activities is very good. There are many opportunities to take part in team events and despite being a very small school, there is competition for places.

In 2017-18 Nether Alderley achieved the Sainsburys Activemark Silver award and in 2018-19 we are aiming to win the gold award.
