Art

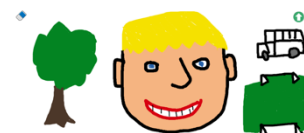
Design a painting or drawing of your family enjoying a safe day by the seaside. Include in your design the safety measures discussed in the video and challenges.
